




Remedy to the increasing darknss of our culture?



See more He posted that he was an English speaker wanting to dialogue in Arabic. Whenever he'd mention that he's Jewish or Israeli, get reaction, "There is no such thing as Israel, just conquered Palestine. It never existed."

"What about thousands years history, Kingdom David, Solomon."

Hearers would laugh. "They were Muslim." I.e., girl near Haifa, said Al Aksa mosque built by multiple prophets, starting with Adam. Avraham, K. Solomon built Al Aksa."

"What about Jewish Temple?"

"Never was a Jewish Temple. Al Aksa mosque built by Abraham who was a Muslim. Yaakov / Jacob on deathbed called his 12 sons to charge them to continue as Muslims. Bnei Yisrael = sons of Israel."

Islam = submission = way of life.

Moshe and all 12 tribes believed in One G-d and prophets sent. G-d took them out of Egypt, gave them Torah at Sinai. All Muslim.

Then some of Bnei Yisrael started sinning in idol worship, golden calf. In rebellion, became Jews.

Yeshua also considered a Muslim Prophet.

Muhammed raised up to restore true faith that Jews had left. Told a girl from Morocco, "Yeshua was a Jew." She started laughing. "He was a Muslim."

Revelations to Moses and Yeshua were perverted by Muslims who became "Jews" so final revelation to Muhammed, the Koran, to bring back truth to world. Jews didn't accept him.

It's their foundational education. All Muslim people have this view, even if apparently secular. No Enlightenment ~ West. World view even by seculars.

One moved to Germany, yet when told Israel given to Jews by G-d, reacted. Land given to Bnei Yisral = Muslims. Became Jews and departed from faith, 10 of 12 spies didn't believe. Jews perverted the Bible text and ideas. Avraham

had many sons who were Muslims. Jews went off the path, and Muslims remained. Jews never accepted Muhammed's correction, so we are cursed. Diaspora, scattered.

Oct 7 all Jews treated as renegades. Secular Jews think Muslims would be OK with them.

Muslims say, "We don't have a problem with the Jews, but with the Zionists." Zionists are Jews who seek sovereignty in Israel.

Jews who live under Muslim reign are OK as dhimmis, special tax. Can't ride on a horse. Walk in the sewers. Sovereignty is threat to Islam.

MB: Judaisms three pillars: Torah, Land, People

Rise of political Zionism was a threat. 250 murdered in Hebron massacre 1929. [in YK Kaddish] Oslo Accord 1993 implement left wing concept "secular" PLO and Israeli Labor Party Yiskhak Rabin. Charters of PLO and Hamas. Hadith: Jews hide behind tree...

All stemming from Islam. Even secular Muslims view Jews NOT in Allah's covenant. Jews are colonial interlopers sent by Europeans.

Whole idea of partner is antithetical to culture.

Caroline Glick: So, how do we explain Abrahamic Accords. MBS Muhammed bin Salman, expanding the rights of women.

MB: People don't support agreements. Govt just in treaties. Military expedience against Iran.

One correspondent: Happy Nasrallah killed, but I'm not a Zionist.

Needed: Change the education.

CG: Channel 11 Israeli poll: 18% still atheist 27% say faith strengthened.

CG: Muslim world view expunges me, negates Jews from existence.

MB: We need to prove it to them. We are Bnei Yisrael. Not give Judea Samaria; concedes they are right.

Three things: strength, respect, G-d. Cf weak and no self respect.

Oslo Sept 1993. First suicide bombing March 1994. Oslo accord made Jihad inevitable.


"Why should we believe this land belongs to you if half of you, Neturei Carta [Ultra Orthodox anti Zionist] and seculars don't believe.

An Israeli source told the Wall Street Journal that Iran had four S-300 air defense batteries, considered the most advanced systems in Iran's air defense network. During Israel's strike on Iran over the weekend, all these systems were destroyed.

"Israel is sending us a very clear message," Hamid Hosseini, an expert in Iran's gas and oil industry, told The New York Times. "This could have very serious economic implications for Iran, and now we understand the risk and that we need to act wisely and not continue with the tension."

Ali Vaez, an Iran researcher, told the Times that the attack could set up a much heavier attack on Iran's nuclear and energy facilities.

"Iran does not have the capability to replace the damaged facilities in the near future," he said.

The attack, which Israel named "Operation Days of Repentance," saw tens of IAF jets, accompanied by refuelers, travel some 1,600 kilometers from Israeli territory. The IAF achieved near uncontested aerial supremacy in Iranian skies.





From the Christians to the Druze, and from the Sunnis to the dominant Shiites, there is a massive revulsion being expressed against the Iranian proxy terrorist group Hezbollah that had bullied its way toward becoming a mafia-like state within a state.

For the first time in over four decades, the Lebanese terrorist group, Hezbollah, appears frail. Following the elimination of the group's leader Hassan Nasrallah by an Israeli airstrike on Beirut on Sep 27, the halo around its invulnerable strength against Israel and other regional rivals faded rapidly.

the open criticism of Hezbollah's reign of terror by leading Lebanese from all religious backgrounds signals the possibility that Iran's chokehold over Lebanon may finally be coming to an end.
