For Israelis, every birth is more than a moment of joy—it's a powerful act of defiance and hope, ensuring life thrives despite adversity.



What is the difference between reformation and revival?

Revival is an inward transformation by an encounter with G-d.

Reformation is a consequent transformation of the religious and moral culture.



REFORMATION



Historically, part of the reason reformation became the label of what happened in the 1500's is that a great deal of time and energy had to be devoted to reforming the externals of the life of the congregation—how they worshiped,

how they educated, how they prepared for immersion—almost everything had to be redone.

Revival is generally internal and subjective...revival moves people from a place of religious stagnation [or rebellion SW] often with the right forms—to a place of personal appropriation of that piety and those convictions.

Both reformation and revival are necessary in our day, both require a work of the Spirit, and both require the powerful preaching of the Word.

Reformation is a consequent transformation of the religious and moral culture.



John Wesley was plagued by his uncertainty of salvation. On May 24th, 1738 he found what he longed for: "In the evening I went very unwillingly to a society in Aldersgate Street, where one was reading Luther's 'Preface to the Epistle to the Romans'.

About a quarter before nine, while he was describing the change which God works in the heart through faith in Messiah, I felt my heart strangely warmed. I felt I did trust in Messiah, Messiah alone for salvation, and an assurance was given me that he had taken away my sins, even mine, and saved me from the law of sin and death."

Wesley shared that message throughout England and America. A great revival resulted, and ultimately there was a great reformation, ending the slave trade in the British Empire through William Wilberforce, a Wesley follower.

In 1807, after nearly two decades of relentless advocacy, Wilberforce's efforts bore fruit. The Abolition Act was passed in the House of Commons with an overwhelming majority. This landmark legislation marked the end of British involvement in the transatlantic slave trade.

Finally, in 1833, the Slavery Abolition Act was passed, ensuring the freedom of all slaves in the British Empire. Wilberforce received the news just days before his death. His life's mission had been accomplished.



Fiji was once known as the Cannibal Isles, and is now known as the Bible Belt of the Pacific Islands.

Then later, in the island nation of Fiji, in 2002, Chief Mataitoga of Sabeto village had a dream from the Lord. The village had a lot of social problems as well as enmity and divisions. As a result of the dream, he called his people together to pray and fast to seek God.

There was a move of the Holy Spirit with real repentance and forgiveness, and unity in the village was restored. The long term results of this action were only revealed with the passing of time.
