

Shmot Ex 12. 18-20 During the first month in the evening of the fourteenth day of the month, you are to eat matzot, [April 12, 2025] until the evening of the twenty-first day of the month [April 19, 2025]. For seven days no hametz is to be found in your houses, for whoever eats hametz, that soul will be cut off from the congregation of Israel, whether he is an outsider or one who is born in the land. You are to eat no hametz; in all your houses you are to eat matzot."

[Serious consequence.]

Land-based commandment. However, Jews everywhere practice it, from Brooklyn to Bangladesh. Non-Jews as well.]

Shmot Ex 12.15 For <u>seven</u> days you are to eat matzot, but on the first day you must remove hametz from your houses, for whoever eats hametz from the first day until the seventh day, that soul will be <u>cut</u> off from Israel.

[Serious consequences. Various interpretations.]

Khametz is a product that is <u>both</u> made from **one of five types of grain** <u>and</u> has been combined with water and left to stand raw for longer than eighteen minutes and **becomes leavened**.

Note: Hebrew is subject to various schemes of transliteration

למֵץ leavened food khametz

Could be hametz, chametz, hamets, chamets, Hametz, etc.

- Leavening agents, such as yeast or baking soda, are not themselves khametz.
- Dry wheat grains are not khametz

Rather, it is these five grains when <u>fermented</u>. Thus yeast may be used in making wine and kefir.

Jews from Europe, Ashkenazi Jews, have an additional restriction to the biblical prohibitions of not eating anything that looks leavened, even if it doesn't rise. Kitniyot ...

Or HaOlam follows the biblical and Sephardic interpretation. Rice is OK. Horchata is OK.

Jews from Europe, Ashkenazi Jews, have an <u>additional day</u> of unleavened bread ... 8 days. Sephardic Jews, from Spain, *Portugal, North Africa, have 7 days unleavened, then a bread fest on the eve of the 8th day.*



Gluten is a structural protein naturally found in certain cereal grains, and usually refers to the elastic network of a wheat grain's proteins, gliadin and glutenin primarily, that forms readily with the addition of water and often kneading in the case of bread dough. The types of grains that contain gluten include all species of wheat, spelt, and barley, rye, and some varieties of oat. [https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Gluten]

- Traditional matzah, an unleavened bread, is made from wheat and is not gluten-free.
- Gluten-free matzah is available but cannot be used for the Seder dinner.

Can gluten-free products contain hametz?

No, gluten-free products should not contain hametz. However, sometimes manufacturers may use ingredients derived from hametz in gluten-free items, rendering them unsuitable for Passover. [https://www.chefsresource.com/faq/are-gluten-free-foods-kosher-for-passover/]

Conclusion if you are gluten intolerant: avoid the five grains, or look for "Kosher for Passover AND "Gluten free." Conclusion otherwise:

- · eat khamets before Friday noon
- bring the remaining for a bonfire

So it's a practice in observant Jewish homes to do a THOROUGH spring cleaning! Get ALL the khametz out of every corner.

Burn the crumbs ... bonfire.


And then a prayer of covering.

^{1 Cor 5.6-8} Your boasting is not good. Don't you know the saying, "It takes only a little *hametz* to leaven a whole batch of dough?" Get rid of the old *hametz*, so that you can be a new batch of dough, because in reality you are unleavened. For our *Pesakh* lamb, the Messiah, has been sacrificed. So let us celebrate the *Seder* not with leftover *hametz*, the *hametz* of **wickedness and evil**, but with the *matzah* of purity and truth.

[Anxiety is the spiritual khamets I think we should address.]




Figure 3. Percentage of adults age 18 and older with symptoms of anxiety in the past 2 weeks, by level of severity of symptoms and sex: United States, 2022

Barry & Cynthia Morehead: Barry attends, from St. Joseph, from time to time, since about 2010. Came with me on the Israel trip when my son Ben was on. He and Cynthia have brought their children up in home school or Christian school. Best nurture in the L-rd they could. We've had lunch together from time to time. I eat lunch for a living.

Many of you heard Barry and Cynthia make their presentation about a year ago.

In 2012 we lost our oldest son to estrangement. He married a woman who by the looks of things seemed to be a good match. A believer well educated, attractive, athletic, from a solid

family. All things true of him as well. They had much in common. However, she wanted him to herself and wanted nothing to do with our family.

The first thing she did after they returned from their honeymoon was to cut off all communication between him and the entire extended family and then begin the process of turning him against us. Six years later our son's high school and college friends began contacting us.

Apparently, she had not only cut off our family but also anyone who knew him prior to her entering his life. My grief was great those first three years. A sister in Messiah recommended a book to aid in my healing.

We had moved our youngest son to Columbia during the pandemic that he may begin his pursuit of his doctorate MU. He was single, lived alone, because of the pandemic he worked remotely and all his classes were being taught online. He would call us five times a week, sometimes alternating, calling his dad one day and me the next.

We were always in touch ... until he went camping **one time** with his sister and her husband. Ever since then he has cut us out of his life as well. He communicated that officially in January of 2022. No explanation other than he is too busy right now to entertain phone calls, texts, or visits from us. That was the last time we heard from him.






