




My daily devotions consist of





Rev 5.12-13 "Worthy is the Lamb who was slain, to receive <u>power and riches and wisdom and might and honor and glory and blessing!"</u>

[What I feel the Ruakh highlighted was:

Rev 5.12-13 And I heard every creature in heaven and on the earth and under the earth and on the sea and everything in them, responding, "To the One seated on the throne and to the Lamb be blessing and honor and glory and power forever and ever!"

[One additional item]

Context

- Revelation Ch 1: Vision of Yeshua amidst the 7 Golden menorot
- Revelation Ch 2-3: Letters to the 7 congregations
- Revelation Ch 4-5: Heavenly Throne room

[Keep this in mind. Heavenly throne room. Many interpretations when this will take place.

Beginning of Great Tribulation, during it, end? Continuously forever?]

Rev 4.2-3 Instantly I was in the Spirit, and there before me in heaven stood a throne, and on the throne Someone was sitting. The One sitting there gleamed like diamonds and rubies, and a rainbow shining like emerald encircled the throne.

[Who was this?? G-d the Father seated on the throne. Keep in mind.]

Rev 4.4-6 Surrounding the throne were twenty-four other thrones, and on the thrones sat twenty-four elders dressed in white clothing and wearing gold crowns on their heads.

[Usually understood to be the redeemed. 12 tribes of Israel, doubled to 12 of the Nations, twelve talmidim /disciples /sent forth ones.]

Rev 4.4-6 From the throne came forth lightnings, voices and thundering; and before the throne were seven flaming torches, which are the sevenfold Spirit of God. In front of the throne was what looked like a sea of glass, clear as crystal.

[So, we saw the Father on the throne, then the sevenfold = seven x perfect Ruakh. More than one entity in G-d. Ekhad is compound unity. Sh'ma ...

Then creatures combined from Ezekiel and Isaiah 6.]

Rev 5.1-5 Next I saw in the right hand of the One sitting on the throne a scroll with writing on both sides and sealed with seven seals; and I saw a mighty angel proclaiming in a loud voice, "Who is worthy to open the scroll and break its seals?"

[Title deed to the universe, forfeited by sin to the enemy. Sealed ~ foreclosed.]

Rev 5.1-5 But no one in heaven, on earth or under the earth was able to open the scroll or look inside it. I cried and cried, because no one was found worthy to open the scroll or look inside it. [Lost state of humanity. Cried and cried, lostness.]

Rev 5.1-5 One of the elders said to me, "Don't cry. Look, the Lion of the tribe of Y'hudah, the Root of David, has won the right to open the scroll and its seven seals."

[Derek Prince: Yeshua was and still IS the Lion of the tribe of Yhudah, Judah]

Rev 5.6-12 And in the midst of the throne and the four living creatures, and in the midst of the elders, I saw a Lamb standing, as having been slain — having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven spirits of God sent out into all the earth.

[Again, Yeshua as differentiated from the Ruakh, differentiated from the Father on the throne

Yn 16.7-8 But I tell you the truth, it is to your advantage that I go away; for if I don't go away, the
comforting Counselor will not come to you. However, if I do go, I will send him to you. "When he
comes, he will show that the world is wrong about sin, about righteousness and about judgment.]

Rev 5.6-12 He came and took the scroll from the right hand of the One seated on the throne.

[He = the Lamb

Seated on the throne = the Father

Note: Two different divine beings.

There is more than one being in the nature of G-d.]

Rev 5.6-12 When He had taken the scroll, the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders fell down before the Lamb, each holding a <u>harp</u> and golden <u>bowls</u> full of incense—which are the prayers of the kedoshim/holy people.

[Fell down = worship

Harp = music

Bowl = incense of prayer.

Hence "Harp and Bowl" to which we added dance to make the Hebrew acronym Prayer + Dance + Song = Teerosh.]

Hence we have a Messianized modification of Harp and Bowl. We call it תַּירוֹשׁ,

Teerosh. This is an acronym based on three Hebrew words

- □ prayer, תפלה, T'feelah,
- □ dance, בקודים, Reekoodeem,
- □ songs, שירים, Sheereem.


קֵירוֹשׁ, Teerosh. As a Hebrew word, it means "new wine" in Biblical Hebrew, or grape juice in modern Hebrew.


So, שׁירוֹשׁ, *Teerosh* is a combination of undulating praise songs and scripture prayer offered up at times antiphonally, and expressed in movement by corporate dance.

Rev 5.6-13 And they are singing a new song, saying, "You are worthy to take the scroll and to open its seals. For You were slain, and by Your blood You redeemed for God those from every tribe and tongue and people and nation. You have made them for our God a kingdom and kohanim, and they shall reign upon the earth." Then I looked, and I heard the voice of many angels around the throne and the living creatures and the elders—their number was myriads of myriads and thousands of thousands. They were chanting with a loud voice, "Worthy is the Lamb who was slain, to receive power and riches and wisdom and might and honor and glory and blessing!"

[Heavenly, premier song of praise. How can we do that? Why these particular items?]

Rev 5.12-13 And I heard every creature in heaven and on the earth and under the earth and on the sea and everything in them, responding, "To the One seated on the throne and to the Lamb <u>be blessing</u> and honor and glory and power forever and ever!"

Daniel 7.13-14 "I kept watching the night visions, when I saw, coming with the clouds of heaven, someone like a son of man. He approached the Ancient One and was led into his presence. To him was given rulership, glory and a kingdom, so that all peoples, [Two divine beings]

Blessed, praised, and glorified, exalted, extolled, and honored, magnified, and lauded be the name of the Holy One,



Rev 5.12-13 And I heard every creature in heaven and on the earth and under the earth and on the sea and everything in them, responding, "To the One seated on the throne and to the Lamb <u>be blessing</u> and honor and glory and power forever and ever!"

Why shout loudly these things?

Should we do the same, or prepare in our spirits to do the same?

Phil 2.9-11 God raised him to the highest place and gave him the name above every name; that in honor of the name given Yeshua, every knee will bow — in heaven, on earth and under the earth — and every tongue will acknowledge that Yeshua the Messiah is Adonai — to the glory of God the Father.

Worthy ἄξιος axios

(áksios) is the root of the English term, "axis." This also refers to a balance-scale, operating by off-setting weights.

[Earth spins on its axis.

By Messiah's atoning execution and attributes all the world spins, hangs, is suspended. We just acknowledge it, as we will see it in His throne room soon enough!!]

is the Lamb who was slain 5x

Sphazó σφάζω: To slay, to slaughter, to kill

While the verb denotes violent killing, its New Covenant range spans deliberate murder, judicial execution, ritual sacrifice, and symbolic imagery.

<u>Sphazó σφάζω : To slay, to slaughter, to kill</u>

The contexts determine whether the act is wicked (Cain, Babylon, the Beast) or redemptive (the Lamb, martyr-witnesses). In every occurrence the death is purposeful, not accidental, and carries theological weight.

[On the reality of His death the whole spiritual world spins!]

power δύναμις dunamis: Power, strength, ability, might, miracle

(for מַיִל, גְבוּרֶה, עֹז, כֹּחַ, צֶבָא an army, a host); strength, ability, power;

universally, "inherent power, power residing in a thing by virtue of its nature, or which a person or thing exerts and puts forth"

[He HAS power. We need to rest in it.]

- specifically, the power of performing miracles
- moral power and excellence of soul
- δύναμις foremost reveals the limitless ability of God, divine omnipotence
- 1. Proclamation—Confidence rests not in human eloquence but in the inherent power of the gospel.
- 2. Personal Holiness—Weakness becomes the arena for Messiah's empowering grace.
- 3. Corporate Worship—Songs and prayers rightly ascribe power to God, nurturing reverent dependence.
- 4. Mission—Evangelism and mercy ministry advance by the same power that raised Yeshua, ensuring hope amid opposition.
- 5. Eschatology—Future expectations of resurrection and consummation flow from God's proven power in history.

<u>riches</u> πλοῦτος <u>ploutos</u>: Riches, wealth, abundance From the base of pletho; wealth (as fulness), i.e. (literally) money, possessions, or (figuratively) abundance, richness, (specially), valuable bestowment – riches.

[Plethora

We are GREATLY blessed already.

Wisdom sophia: ססשה, wisdom, broad and full intelligence

Ro 11.33-35 O the depth of the riches, both of the wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are His judgments and how incomprehensible His ways! For "who has known the mind of Adonai, or who has been His counselor?" Or "who has first given to Him, that it shall be repaid to him?" [He HAS wisdom for us. Acknowledge it. Enjoy it.]

Heavenly wisdom, in contrast, "is first pure, then peace-loving, gentle, accommodating, full of mercy and good fruit, impartial, and sincere" (Yaakov 3:17). The way to obtain it remains simple: "If any of you lacks wisdom, he should ask God" (Yaakov 1:5).

Paul distinguishes two kinds of sophia: the passing wisdom of this age and the "hidden wisdom of God" (1 Corinthians 2:6-7). Preaching must therefore rest "not on man's wisdom but on the power of God" (1 Corinthians 2:5). Yet mature believers do speak wisdom—illumined by the Spirit, not philosophy.

1 Cor 1.25-27 For the foolishness of God is wiser than men, and the weakness of God is stronger than men. For you see your calling, brothers and sisters, that not many are wise according to human

standards, not many are powerful, and not many are born well. Yet God chose the foolish things of the world so He might put to shame the wise; and God chose the weak things of the world so He might put to shame the strong;

[Gary Selden, founder of Jonathan Cahn's congregation. Prosperous Jewish businessman came to faith. Unusual. No trauma rescue.]

might ἰσχύς ischus:

Strength, might, power,

from the Gk root is, "force"

and /exō, "have") – properly, force to overcoming immediate resistance. inherent strength, It is not merely the exercise of power (as with δύναμις) but the capacity or resource that makes such action possible.

[Like David to overcome Golyat/Goliath]

Shaul/Paul prays that believers would know "the surpassing greatness of His power toward us who believe... the might of His strength" (Ephesians 1:19). The resurrection and exaltation of Messiah prove that God's $i\sigma\chi\dot{u}\zeta$ is operative on behalf of the believers.

Honor τιμή timé:

value, price, respect

In the Greco-Roman world, honor was a limited good fought over in public competition. Scripture reorients that culture: honor is received from God and shared in self-sacrificing love. Be devoted to one another in brotherly love. Outdo yourselves in **honoring** one another" (Romans 12:10).

Self-forgetting esteem imitates the Triune pattern of deferential love.

glory δόξα doxa:

Glory, honor, splendor, majesty, good opinion, judgment, view:

(from dokeō, "exercising personal opinion which determines value")

As a translation of the Hebrew בָּבוּי in a use foreign to Greek: splendor, brightness;

^{2 Cor 3.18} So, all of us, with faces unveiled, see as in a mirror the glory of the Lord; and we are being changed into his very image, from one degree of **glory** to the next, by Adonai the Spirit.

^{2 Cor 4.6} For God, who said, "Let light shine out of darkness," is the One who has shone in our hearts, to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Messiah.

Blessing εὐλογία eulogia:

praise, benefit

- the full biblical idea of a verbal or enacted bestowal of good that comes ultimately from God.
- God's favor, once pledged in promise to Abraham, now overflows through Messiah Yeshua and returns to God in praise.


Power κράτος kratos:

Power, might, dominion, strength

krátos (from a root meaning "to perfect, complete," dominion, exerted power)
