What empowers our community identity?

When we say <u>Welcome Immanuel עַמַנוּאֵל בַּרוּךְ הַבַּא Immanuel, Barukh Haba</u>

1. We are in one word acknowledging the whole plan of salvation: His coming to earth, living among us, G-d with us. Coming to earth of G-d! to be with us, walk with us, suffer with us, then for us, then in us!

[If you have a saving relationship with Yeshua, this invites him into your life.

If you don't have a saving relationship with Yeshua, this concept should draw you to such!!]

- 2. We are welcoming Him to rule in our lives, our emotions, our relationships as G-d/man with us.
- 3. We are giving Him authority over our response to life, to difficulties, to needs.



Yn 17.17-23 "Make them holy in the truth. Your word is truth. Just as You sent Me into the world, so I have sent them into the world. And for their sakes I make Myself holy, so that they also may be made holy in truth. I pray not on behalf of these only,

[Holy, Messiah like in character, relationships.]

Yn 17.17-23 but also for those who believe in Me through their message, that <u>they all may be one</u>. Just as You, Father, are in Me and I am in You, so also may they be

one in Us, so the world may believe that You sent Me.

[Essence of holiness of character is deep unity.

This is the primary evidence of the divine mission, the deity of Yeshua the Messiah!]

Yn 17.17-23 The glory that You have given to Me I have given to them, that they may be one just as We are one— I in them and You in Me—that they may be perfected in unity, so that the world may know that You sent Me and loved them as You loved Me.

[Liquid love, Presence

Repeat: Essence of holiness of character is deep unity. This is the primary evidence of the divine mission, the deity of Yeshua the Messiah!]

Eph 4.29-32 Let no harmful word come out of your mouth, but only what is beneficial for building others up according to the need, so that it gives grace to those who hear it. Do not grieve the Ruach ha-Kodesh of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption. Get rid of all bitterness and rage and anger and quarreling and slander, along with all malice. Instead, be kind to one another, compassionate, forgiving each other just as God in Messiah also forgave you.

Eph 1.4-6 He chose us in the Messiah before the foundation of the world, to be holy and blameless before Him in love. He predestined us for adoption as sons through Messiah Yeshua, in keeping with the good pleasure of His will — to the glorious praise of His grace, with which <u>He has accepted us</u> through the One He loves!

[Rejection is a BIG issue. According to RTF founders, Jim Keelstra, abandonment underlies all other wounds. Disputes are NOT, ≠ personal rejection.]

An illustration of community from nature.



A program by National Geographic gives a powerful illustration for us. In the great annual wildebeest migration in Serengeti National Park in Africa a giant herd, thousands of wildebeest, slowly move in groups across the plain. They are invariably followed by stalking lions.

But the lions never attack the herd – they simply watch carefully for the stray wildebeest, either careless or seeking greener grass, who separates himself from the larger groups of animals. The isolated wildebeest will become the sudden prey of the lions who attack with

lightning speed and ferocity.

In spiritual warfare isolation is equally dangerous, as our enemy roams like a roaring lion looking for separated brethren to prey upon. We all need real relationship and spiritual community for protection against our enemy who is constantly stalking vulnerable prey.

It's not enough to simply "go to service." We need to be the community of believers, <u>actively participating in loving, serving, praying, counseling, giving/ tithing, encouraging, admonishing, eating, rejoicing, weeping, and forgiving as the family of God.</u>

Living in His inheritance of forgiving, execution stake love also means trusting Him in apparently bad things.

In a carefully controlled laboratory at Carnegie Mellon University, researchers exposed more than 400 healthy volunteers to the common cold virus ... Participants who were hugged on most days had about 60 percent lower odds of becoming infected than those who were rarely hugged. Additionally, those who did get sick recovered more quickly and had stronger immune responses than those who received fewer hugs.

On a neurochemical level, hugging triggers the release of several "feel-good" chemicals. Chief among these is oxytocin, endorphins, <u>dopamine</u>. One-second hugs felt unsatisfying and provided minimal benefit. At the same time, five to 10 seconds proved optimal before longer contact became uncomfortable.

Mtt 18.15-17 "Now if your brother sins against you, go and show him his fault while you're with him alone.

Disputes are NOT, ≠ personal rejection. [Rabbi, fix this ...]

Gal 6.1-2 Brothers and sisters, if someone is caught doing something wrong, you who are directed by the Ruach, restore such a person in a spirit of gentleness — [Cf complaint, denunciation, and tell him or her off. Give him a piece of my mind (assuming you have a piece to spare!)]

<sup>Gal 6.1-2</sup> looking closely at yourself so you are not tempted also. Bear one another's burdens, and in this way you fulfill the Torah of Messiah.

Mtt 18.15-17 If he listens to you, you have won your brother. But if he does not listen, <u>take with you one</u> <u>or two more</u>, so that 'by the mouth of two or three witnesses every word may stand.'

[That's where me or Jeremy or Ulises or our wives come in, or a professional counselor.]

Mtt 18.15-17 But if he refuses to listen to them, tell it to Messiah's community. And if he refuses to listen even to Messiah's community, let him be to you as a pagan and a tax collector.

[But how do we feel about outsiders, not-yet-believers? Compassion, grief, solicitousness!!]

(TLV) Hebrews 12:15 See to it that no one falls short of the grace of God; and see to it that no bitter root springs up and causes trouble, and by it many be defiled.

Nosh: Unresolved bitterness towards others is like a contagious disease. The longer one has it the more it makes sick the embittered person as well as infecting and defiling those around them with a divisive and negative spirit.

It is essential that we quickly resolve held bitterness towards others and also choose to minimize or, if possible, avoid those who are carrying such a spiritual infection.



Community. Support. Revolving door?]




